

IDAHO FEDERATION OF REPUBLICAN WOMEN STANDING RULES OF ORDER

In addition to the provisions of the IFRW Bylaws, the following Standing Rules of Order shall be adopted.

- 1. IFRW dues shall be \$14.00, which includes the NFRW dues of \$10.00.
- 2. The annual Club service charge of \$25 shall be submitted to the IFRW Treasurer by January 30, or upon organization of a new club.
- 3. The IFRW Treasurer asks that club treasurers submit dues and contact information regularly to keep our data accurate.
- 4. IFRW shall expect club presidents or a designated appointee, to attend all State Board meetings and the State Biennial Conventions.
- 5. IFRW Board meetings shall be held in the Spring and Fall of each year; the Biennial Convention will be the Fall meeting in even years. Every effort will be made to encourage clubs in different geographic areas of the state to host Board meetings and Convention to allow access for all members.
- 6. The IFRW Executive Committee will meet preceding Spring and Fall Board of Directors meetings and at the conclusion of the Biennial Convention. Conference calls may be used to conduct business as deemed necessary by the President.
- 7. IFRW Officers and Committee Chairmen shall submit written reports to the President two weeks prior to the Spring and Fall Board meetings and the Biennial Convention.
- 8. A reserve of \$5,000 shall be kept in the IFRW treasury. This reserve may only be available for use upon members' vote at an IFRW Board meeting.
- 9. Reimbursement for expenditures by individuals must have prior approval of the president, and be submitted, together with a receipt, to the IFRW Treasurer for payment.
- 10. A reserve of \$1,000 shall be kept in the Dedra Morris Scholarship fund and may only be used upon vote of members at an IFRW Board meeting.
- 11. Campaign contributions to Republican candidates elected at the Primary Election may be approved by the Executive Committee. Contributions exceeding \$1,000 will require a vote of members at a State Board meeting.
- 12. IFRW fundraising projects shall include, but not be limited to, membership in Syringa Regents and the Elected Officials Club; Sponsorships for Board Meetings and Conventions; and Red Bag events at Board Meetings, IDGOP Meetings, and IFRW and IDGOP Conventions.
- 13. A "Tribute to Women" breakfast shall be held in conjunction with the biennial IDGOP Convention to honor women chosen by each Club. At the Spring Board meeting prior to the IDGOP Convention, the IFRW shall also choose a woman to honor at the Tribute breakfast.
